If other thoughts and questions stick out to you, discuss those as well. The goal is simply for us to learn from God's Word this morning and grow together, even while apart.

- Vs. 2-8, also 12: How is joy possible when facing trouble?
 - O Why is perseverance such a crucial quality for a Christian?
 - O When we ask God for wisdom, how does He answer us?
- Vs. 13-15, what is the process of temptation and sin?
 - So how do we defeat temptation? (See Matthew 4, 1 Corinthians 10:13)
- Vs. 19-21, Why is verse 19 so difficult to live out?
 - How is verse 21 an antidote, a battle plan for verses 19-20?

- Vs. 22-25, according to verse 22, we are not to just listen to the Word, we are also supposed to what?
 - What practical things can we do to make sure we are putting into practice what we hear or read or learn from God's Word?
 - Verse 25 tells us that this perfect law (God's Word) gives freedom. How does the Bible give freedom?




