If other thoughts and questions stick out to you, discuss those as well. The goal is simply for us to learn from God's Word this morning and grow together, even while apart.

- As you read this passage, what are some of the ways this people showed faith and trust in God? What are some of the things that had to give up in order to follow God? What did God do in and through them due to their faithful obedience?
- Vs 24-26 is probably my favorite verses in this chapter. There are a few descriptions of what Moses is choosing over other things. What is Moses choosing and what is he choosing that over?
 - What are the pleasures of sin and why are the pleasures of sin only for a short time?
- In this chapter of ordinary people who did great things through faith, who jumps out at you the most? Who do you relate to? Who really challenges you?
