- Vs. 3-12 talk about the power of the tongue.
 - 3-5 talks about how the tongue can steer the whole person. What do you think that means and how do you see that play out?
 - Look up these other verses and what do they tell us about the power of our words:
 - Proverbs 16:24
 - Proverbs 18:21
 - Proverbs 21:23
 - Psalm 19:14
 - Psalm 141:3
 - Ephesians 4:29
 - Colossians 4:6
 - Titus 3:1-2
 - John 13:35

- 9-10 for me is a hit me square in the face as we can so easily praise God one moment and two seconds later tear down someone else. How should the belief that all our made in God's image affect how we treat others and speak of others?
- O Who is someone who speaks life into you?
- Vs 13-18 compares two kinds of wisdom
 - From this passage and also other Biblical principles, how does earthly wisdom and heavenly wisdom differ?
 - We live in a world of such tension and God calls us to be peacemakers.
 What are practical ways that we can be peacemakers in our world today?
- What other things, verses, words are you thinking about from James 3 other than what has already been discussed?
- Close your time in prayer
- CHALLENGE: Text or call at least 2 people (go for as many you want) this afternoon sometime and share with them one thing that you learned from James 2 today. If you have social media, consider putting what you learned on there, as well.




